

AUTOLOAD

When a file is defined, TCP/IP normally checks to see that the appropriate file I/O driver is loaded and initialized. By turning automatic loading off, file I/O drivers can be loaded under control of DEFINE FILEIO.

Syntax: AUTOLOAD {ON|OFF}

Arguments:

ON - File I/O drivers are loaded and initialized when a file is defined of the appropriate type. This is the default setting

OFF - File I/O drivers are not automatically loaded and initialized.

Example:

```
IPN237I autoload on
IPN268I AutoLoad now set to On
```

Related	DEFINE FILE	- Define a file in the TCP/IP file systems and associate it with a file I/O driver.
Commands:	DEFINE FILEIO	- Defines a file I/O driver for a file type
	QUERY FILES	- Displays the contents of the TCP/IP file system.
	QUERY FILEIO	- Displays the status of the File I/O driver programs.
