

DELETE HTTPD

The DELETE HTTPD command removes an HTTP Daemon (server) from the system.

Syntax: `DELeTe HTTPd ID=id`

Arguments: `ID=` - The `ID=` value used to define the HTTP Daemon that is to be deleted.

Example:

```
IPN237I delete http,id=h1
HTT903I Daemon Shutdown HTTP
```

Notes:

- Note that there is no MODIFY HTTPD command. To change specifications, you must delete and redefine the Daemon.

Commands:	QUERY HTTPDS	- Displays the status of the Hypertext Transfer Protocol (web server) Daemons.
