DELETE HTTPD

The DELETE HTTPD command removes an HTTP Daemon (server) from the system.

Syntax: DELete HTTPd ID=id

Arguments: ID= - The ID= value used to define the HTTP Daemon that is to be deleted.

Example:

IPN237I delete http,id=hl HTT903I Daemon Shutdown HTTP

Notes: • Note that there is no MODIFY HTTPD command. To change specifications, you must delete and redefine the Daemon.
