

DELETE LPD

The DELETE LPD command removes an LPD (server) from the system. If the LPD is currently in use, it is flagged for deletion as soon as it finishes the current operation.

Syntax: **DELeTe LPD ID=*id***

Arguments: **ID=** - The PRINTER= value used to define the LPD that is to be deleted.

Example:

```
query lpd
IPN253I << TCP/IP Line Printer Daemons >>
IPN444I  Print Name: HEX UserID: $LPD Hexdump Mode
IPN445I      Queue: POWER.LST.A.
IPN446I      Library: MEMORY.
IPN444I  Print Name: LOCAL UserID: $LPD
IPN445I      Queue: POWER.LST.A.
IPN446I      Library: MEMORY.

delete lpd,id=local
LPD932I LPD queue scheduled for deletion: LOCAL
LPD935I LPD queue deleted: LOCAL

query lpd
IPN253I << TCP/IP Line Printer Daemons >>
IPN444I  Print Name: HEX UserID: $LPD Hexdump Mode
IPN445I      Queue: POWER.LST.A.
IPN446I      Library: MEMORY.
```

Commands:	FLUSH	- Terminate all processing with a specific remote host.
