DELETE NAME

The DELETE NAME command removes an entry from the symbolic name table.

Syntax: DELete NAME NAME={name|DYNAMIC}

Arguments: NAME= - The symbolic name to be deleted. Case is ignored. A special reserved name,

"DYNAMIC", can be specified to delete all cached DNS entries.

Example:

IPN237I delete name, name=devpun

IPN581I Name DEVPUN has been deleted.

Related Commands:

DEFINE NAME

- Associate a TCP/IP name with an IP address or a script file.

QUERY NAMES - Displays TCP/IP names and the values associated with them.
