

DELETE NAME

The DELETE NAME command removes an entry from the symbolic name table.

Syntax: `DELeTe NAME NAME={name|DYNAMIC}`

Arguments: NAME= - The symbolic name to be deleted. Case is ignored. A special reserved name, "DYNAMIC", can be specified to delete all cached DNS entries.

Example:

```
IPN237I delete name,name=devpun
IPN581I Name DEVPUN has been deleted.
```

Related	DEFINE NAME	- Associate a TCP/IP name with an IP address or a script file.
Commands:	QUERY NAMES	- Displays TCP/IP names and the values associated with them.
