

DELETE NTPD

The DELETE NTPD command removes a Network Time Protocol Daemon from the system.

Syntax: `DELeTe NTPd ID=id`

Arguments: `ID=` - The ID that identifies the Daemon to be deleted.

Example:

```
IPN237I delete ntpd,id=ntp1
NTP102I NTP Daemon shutdown complete
```
