ISOLATION

The ISOLATION command prevents remote hosts from establishing connections with *TCP/IP for VSE* Daemons or applications.

Syntax: ISOLAtion $\{ON | OFF\}$

Arguments: ON - This setting prevents all inbound connection requests. Outbound requests continue to

function.

OFF - This setting permits inbound connection requests to be made.

Example:

IPN237I isolation on IPN268I ISOLATION now set to ON

Notes: • This feature is useful only when you absolutely do not want any remote access to your system.

Related Commands:

QUERY OPTIONS - Displays the current values of modifiable parameters.
