

ISOLATION

The ISOLATION command prevents remote hosts from establishing connections with *TCP/IP* for *VSE* Daemons or applications.

Syntax: ISOLation {ON|OFF}

Arguments: ON - This setting prevents all inbound connection requests. Outbound requests continue to function.

OFF - This setting permits inbound connection requests to be made.

Example:

```
IPN237I isolation on
IPN268I ISOLATION now set to ON
```

Notes:

- This feature is useful only when you absolutely do not want any remote access to your system.

Related Commands: QUERY OPTIONS - Displays the current values of modifiable parameters.
