

QUERY FILEIO

The QUERY FILEIO command displays information pertaining to the installed file I/O drivers.

Syntax: Query FILEIo [,SYSLst]

Arguments: SYSLst - If specified, the results of this request are sent to SYSLST. If omitted, the results are displayed on the console.

Example:

```
IPN237I query fileio
IPN253I << TCP/IP File I/O Drivers >>
IPN640I  REXX      Driver: IPNFREXX Entry: 805D3050 Use: 0
IPN640I  LIBRARY  Driver: IPNFLIBR Entry: 805BC050 Use: 0
IPN640I  POWER    Driver: IPNFPOWR Entry: 005B2050 Use: 0
```
