

# QUERY LOCKS

---

The QUERY LOCKS command displays information on the stack's internal lock mechanism.

---

Syntax: Query LOCKs [,SYSLst]

---

Arguments: SYSLst - If specified, the results of this request are sent to SYSLST. If omitted, the results are displayed on the console.

---

Example:

IPN237I query locks
IPN253I << TCP/IP Lock Information >>
