

# QUERY LOGS

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This command allows you to inspect the status of *TCP/IP for VSE*'s various displays and logs.

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Syntax: Query LOGs [,SYSLst]

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Arguments: SYSLst - If specified, the results of this request are sent to SYSLST. If omitted, the results are displayed on the console.

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Example:
