

QUERY LPDS

The QUERY LPDS command enables you to display the status of currently defined Line Printer Daemons.

Syntax: `Query LPds [,ID=id] [,SYSlst]`

Arguments: `ID=` - The ID of a Line Printer Daemon, as specified by the DEFINE LPD command. If this operand is omitted, all Line Printer Daemons are displayed.

`SYSlst` - If specified, the results of this request are sent to SYSLST. If omitted, the results are displayed on the console.

Example:

```
IPN237I query lpds
IPN253I << TCP/IP Line Printer Daemons >>
IPN444I Print Name: HEX UserID: $LPD Hexdump Mode
IPN445I Queue: POWER.LST.A.
IPN446I Library: MEMORY.
IPN444I Print Name: LOCAL UserID: $LPD
IPN445I Queue: POWER.LST.A.
IPN446I Library: MEMORY.
```
