

QUERY MENUS

The QUERY MENUS command displays the menu currently available for use by Telnet Daemons.

Syntax: Query MENUs [,SYSLst]

Arguments: SYSLst - If specified, the results of this request are sent to SYSLST. If omitted, the results are displayed on the console.

Example:

```
IPN237I query menu
IPN253I << TCP/IP Menu Definitions >>
IPN391I  ID: MENUUSR           Member: MENU2
IPN391I  ID: MENUADM           Member: MENU1
```

	DELETE MENU	- Remove a TN3270 menu file from memory.
