## **QUERY NAMES**

The QUERY NAMES command enables you to inspect the contents of the symbolic names table.

Syntax: Query NAMes [,TYPe={ALL|STATIC|DYNAMIC}] [,SYSlst]

Arguments: TYPe= - May be specified to display a subset of the defined names.

STATIC - Only names that were explicitly defined with a DEFINE NAME command

will be displayed. This is the default.

DYNAMIC - Only those names that were resolved by means of a DNS and are currently in

the cache will be displayed.

ALL - Both static and dynamic entries will be displayed.

SYSIst - If specified, the results of this request are sent to SYSLST. If omitted, the results are displayed on the console.
