

# QUERY PRODKEYS

---

The QUERY PRODKEYS command allows you to inspect the various product keys currently in use.

---

Syntax: Query PRODkeys [,SYSLst]

---

Arguments: SYSLst - If specified, the results of this request are sent to SYSLST. If omitted, the results are - displayed on the console.

---

Example:

```
IPN237I query prodkeys
IPN253I << TCP/IP Product Keys >>
IPN886I Stack..... (CSI) Expires on 2010/12/15
IPN886I SSL..... (CSI) Expires on 2010/12/15
IPN886I GPS..... (CSI) Expires on 2010/12/15
IPN886I SecureFTP... (CSI) Expires on 2010/12/15
IPN886I HFS..... (CSI) Expires on 2010/12/15
```

Notes: • When multiple keys are present for a particular feature, TCP/IP selects the "best" available key.

Related Commands: QUERY PROGRAMS - Displays the program phases being used by TCP/IP, their characteristics, their memory locations, and the library from which each was loaded.
