

QUERY SECURITY

The QUERY SECURITY command allows you to display the current security status of the TCP/IP partition.

Syntax: Query SECURITY [,SYSlst]

Example:

```
IPN237I query security
IPN253I << TCP/IP Security Settings >>
IPN750I   Security Processing: Enabled
IPN750I   ARP Checking:          Disabled
IPN750I   IP Address Checking:  Disabled
IPN751I   Exit data:            Undefined
IPN750I   Automatic Security:   Enabled ARP=  BLOCKIP=Y FTPC=  FTPD=  ICMP=Y IPAV=  WEBL=
IPN750I   Security Exit:        Undefined
IPN750I   Batch Security:       Disabled
IPN752I   Security Mode: Fail Log: Fail Dump: Fail
```
