

QUERY TRUSTED

The QUERY TRUSTED command displays a list of IP addresses that have been marked as “trusted”.

Syntax: Query TRUSTed [,SYSLst]

Arguments: SYSLst - If specified, the results of this request are sent to SYSLST. If omitted, the results are displayed on the console.

Example:

```
IPN237I query trusted
IPN253I << TCP/IP Trusted IP Addresses >>
IPN127I 192.168.1.66
IPN127I 192.168.1.1
12.182.34.168
```

Related Commands: TRUST - Establish that an IP address is trusted and suspicious activity is to be ignored.
