

QUERY USERS

The QUERY USERS command lists the contents of the user ID table. This table is constructed by using the DEFINE USER command.

Syntax: Query USERS [,NAME=*name*] [,SYSLST]

Arguments: NAME= - Displays a specific entry based on the user ID. User IDs are not case sensitive. If more than one entry matches the user ID (that is, if there is a duplicate entry), all matching entries are displayed. Note that the security processor recognizes only the first entry.

SYSLST - If specified, the results of this request are sent to SYSLST. If omitted, the results are displayed on the console.

Example:

```
IPN237I query users
IPN253I << TCP/IP User IDs >>
IPN475I User ID: TBDBITL
IPN883I Valid for: Web
IPN475I User ID: UPLOAD
IPN883I Valid for: *All*
IPN475I User ID: GUEST
IPN883I Valid for: *All*
IPN475I User ID: AUTOFTP
IPN883I Valid for: FTP, LPR
IPN475I User ID: EWF
IPN883I Valid for: FTP, LPR, Web, Telnet
```
