

RESUME

The RESUME command is used to resume execution of a pseudo-task that has been suspended by means of the SUSPEND command.

Syntax: RESume *tasknum*

Arguments: *tasknum* - Specifies the hexadecimal task number of the task to be resumed.

Example:

```
IPN237I resume 000d
IPN477I Task 000D has resumed in phase IPNIGARB. Disp: 3,855
```

Related	QUERY TASKS	- Displays a list of pseudo tasks.
Commands:	SUSPEND	- Halts processing by a pseudo task.
