

# SEGMENT

---

The SEGMENT command segments the SYSLST file. This enables you to obtain a partial SYSLST file without shutting down TCP/IP for VSE.

---

Syntax: SEGment [NEW]

---

Arguments: NEW - Directs *TCP/IP for VSE* to issue the IPWSEGM macro instead of the SEGMENT macro. Some customers have reported problems with IPWSEGM, so the default is to use the older SEGMENT macro. SEGMENT NEW can be used on systems running VSE/ESA 2.2 or later.

---

Example:

```
IPN237I segment
IPN480I TCP/IP for VSE log has been segmented.
```

Notes: 

- When SEGMENT is issued, the characteristics of the SYSLST file are reset to VSE defaults.

---

Related	DEFINE LOG	- Create a system log file.
Commands:	MESSAGE	- Controls message suppression.
	MODIFY LOG	- Changes characteristics of a system log file.
	QUERY LOGS	- Displays available consoles and logs, along with their properties.
