

# SET DNST

---

Each SET DNST command specifies a timeout value for its corresponding SET DNS command. For example, the SET DNST1= command specifies the timeout value for the DNS server specified by the SET DNS1 command.

---

Syntax: SET DNST $n$ =*sec300*

---

Arguments:  $n$  - Numeric value, 1 through 4

The DNS entry to set. Up to four Domain Name Servers can be used.

---

*sec300* - Numeric, 300 through 65535, in 300th seconds

Specifies the timeout value to be used for the corresponding domain name server entry. The default value is 1200, or 4 seconds.

---

Example:

```
IPN237I set dnst1=1500
IPN254I DNS 1 address is 65.24.7.3, Timeout is 1500
```

Related	QUERY OPTIONS	- Displays the current values of modifiable parameters.
Commands:	SET DNS	- Establishes a DNS server to be used for name resolution.
