## TRUST

The TRUST command allows you to assign or remove an IP address's "trusted" status. A "trusted" IP address is never subjected to having its access to VSE revoked based on suspicious activity. TRUSt {ADD|DELete} ,IPaddress=ip4addr Syntax: Arguments: ADD - The specified address will be marked as "trusted". **DELete** - The specified address will no longer be marked as "trusted". IPaddress= - Specifies the IP address that is to have its "trusted" status updated. Example: IPN237I trust add, ipaddress=192.168.1.66 IPN237I query trust IPN253I << TCP/IP Trusted IP Addresses >> IPN127I 192.168.1.66 IPN127I 192.168.1.1 12.182.34.168 Related ACCESS

Control access to VSE by IP address -

Displays the currently "trusted" IP addresses -
