WAITFOR

The WAITFOR command suspends TCP/IP for VSE initialization until the specified event has occurred.

Syntax: WAITfor VTam

Arguments: VTam - Initialization pauses until the stack has detected that VTAM has initialized.

Example:

```
IPN237I WAITFOR VTAM
IPN394I Testing for an active VTAM partition
IPN395I Waiting for VTAM to become active
IPN395I Waiting for VTAM to become active
IPN396I VTAM is active and functioning
```

Notes: • If WAITFOR is encountered as a command after the stack's dispatcher has become active, it is ignored.

Commands: INCLUDE - Includes a library member in the initialization parameter set.
